SUPPLIES

Laceweight yarn

(we used this organic cotton laceweight yarn)

vellum and iron-on transfer pen

or

freezer paper and pen

TRANSFER PEN METHOD

(best for light colored fabrics / smooth weave fabrics)

Print out fox pattern.



Trace onto vellum using transfer pen.
Iron vellum (traced side facing down)
onto fabric to transfer pattern.
Thread needle with your yarn of
choice. Bring needle from the back
of the fabric to the front (through

the dot pictured in step one) leaving a 3 in tail at back. Backstitch as shown in steps 1, 2, & 3 all the way around the fox head outline.

Following steps 4 & 5, make two small French knots for the eyes.

Pull thread to back and tie off.

FREEZER PAPER METHOD

(best for dark fabrics/textured fabrics)

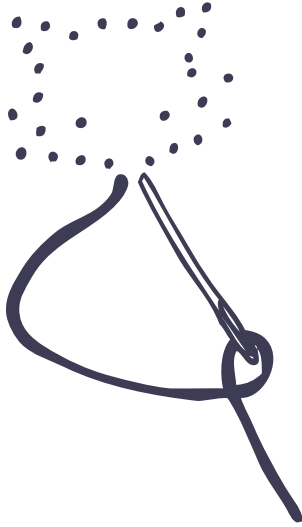
Print out fox pattern.



Trace onto freezer paper. Iron the freezer paper on the fabric you wish to embroider. Embroider following the same steps as the Transfer pen method.
